WHAT WE COLLECT

ITEMS

We accept the following items:

- all types of pencils
- crayons
- pencil cases
- rulers
- erasers
- sharpeners
- unused exercise books / note pads/ scrap books
- highlighters
- pens
- glue
- art books, paints and paint brushes
- maths equipment (protractors etc)
- staplers and staples

Please do not send items that are broken, have parts missing and not working where possible.

ABOUT US

Stationery Aid was created out of need to collect used and unused excess school stationery items rather than sending them to landfill.

Our purpose is to create a not for profit community based initiative that collects, sorts, cleans, renews and repacks school stationery items that are donated to disadvantaged students and families in need of education resources. We partner with community volunteering organisations who contribute to helping make a difference to the lives of those in need.

Our pilot program in 2020 involving 17 schools and organisations, collected enough unwanted stationery for us to create 97 booklist and stationery packs reaching 106 school students across 13 schools. Additionally, we diverted approximately 78 x 120 L recycling bins of stationery from landfill.

COLLECTION POINTS

If you would like to join us as a collection partner, we will supply you with a stationery aid recycling bin where your school or business community can donate used and unused stationery items. We will empty the bin on an as needs basis.

In return, we kindly ask that you promote the Stationery Aid collection point within your school community because the more we collect the more we can make a difference.

At the end of the school year, we also collect unwanted classroom stationery which will go towards our school stationery packs.

Any items we cannot use will go to recycling where possible to achieve a full circular economy.
